


Kinship & Foster Care Program

A Kinship and Foster Care program for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Carers in the Bayside and surrounding areas

Kinship Care is the nurturing and protection of children by relatives or any adult who has a kinship bond with the child.





What do we do?

The Yulu-Burri-Ba Kinship & Foster Care Program recruits, trains, assesses and supports Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islander carers.

Our aim is to place Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islander children with appropriate carers ensuring they remain connected with their cultural identity and retain relationships with their families and community.

Provide support for the care of children and young people
Direct worker support in the home
Emotional support
Practical support
Help you explore training options
Understand your child's
development and needs
Regular check-ins with you to maintain care arrangements
Support in understanding the use of the Kinship & Foster Carer Connect app.

How to become a carer
